GENERAL INFORMATION

St. Joseph's High School, Patancheru is a Christian (Catholic) Minority Education Institution a branch of Divine Word Educational Society, Regd. No. 3704/1995

Admissions

This institution is co-educational. Admission is open to all irrespective of caste and creed.

1. Every candidate for admission must be introduced personally by their parents or guardians in person who will be responsible to the principal for the child.
2. New admissions will be made subject to their being vacancies. No correspondence or recommendations will be entertained regarding admissions.
3. Parents or Guardians are given to understand that they cannot dictate to the management and that the management to say on what condition it will admit or retain pupils in the school. Admission is entirely at the direction of the principal.
4. Every Pupil must bring: A Transfer (Leaving) Certificate, if he/she comes from a recognised schools. If they should come from recognised School outside the state, they shall have their leaving certificate countersigned by the Inspecting Authority of that state
 - i. Birth Certificate issued by a competent Govt./Municipal authority/ Mandal Revenue Officer.
 - ii. Caste Certificate for SC, ST and BC students.
 - iii. Record sheets in case of Primary Section
 - iv. Direct admission will be made for primary High School classes on Entrance Test.
5. No child less than five year of age at the time of admission is admitted to the First Standard. A corresponding scale of age is fixed for the subsequent classes.
6. Application forms can be obtained from the office.
7. In case of last admission of the pupils, the fee from the beginning of the first semester shall be charged unless the fee for the period,

before admission had been paid to some other school.

Rules for fees

1. Fee must be paid at the fee counter during the following hours only: 9 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. to 4 p.m.
2. No deductions will be made for broken periods of school attendance.
3. Fee defaulters will not be allowed to appear for Examinations unless the fee is paid.
4. Parents unable to pay the fee on time due to unforeseen circumstances should meet the principal and get the date on which they will be able to pay, failing which the children will not be admitted to the class.

School examinations

1. There are four Formative Assessments and two Summative Assessments.
2. Before an examination the fee cards will be checked to see if the school fee payments have been made according to the regulations of school. Fee defaulters will not be allowed to appear for the exam until the dues are paid.

3. Pupils who are absent for an examination for any reason whatsoever are not re-examined and those absent without grave reason will be considered as having failed.
4. Absence from whole examination involves a total loss of marks.
5. Students failing any subject will not be ranked at all.
6. Wilful breach of any other regulations, for the conduct of the examination is punishable with expulsion from the examination room. If this misdemeanour has been discovered subsequently, the pupil will forfeit his/her marks.

Public examination

First sufficient reasons such as unsatisfactory progress in studies, irregular attendance, habitable late coming, insubordination to Principal or Teachers, serious misconduct, dishonesty or any absence from a test/examination, non payment of school fees, a pupil's name may be withdrawn from the list of candidates even though he/she has passed the public examination.
